### **Vice President's Message:**

It's that time of the year again and a perfect time to make sure you start posting all of your scores. Here are the guidelines.

### **It is a player's responsibility, not their playing partners, to post ALL of eligible ESC scores as soon as practical after a round.**

This means you should post the score immediately at the course you played or if that is not practical then post it at Santa Ana within 24 hours or via the Internet if you are not going to Santa Ana for a while. You should also post scores for groups like Senior Golfers of NM who do not post scores for their players. Be aware that many other groups like Roadrunners do post most scores for their players. If they do not, then you are responsible for doing it. **The Players Club will post all eligible Santa Ana tournament scores to GHIN.**

### **Many players do not want to post all of their scores for many reasons.**

Almost all scores are eligible for posting. Trying to manipulate the system by withholding good or bad scores defeats the purpose of the handicap system and will result in a differential that does not reflect your current playing potential. The result is that you may either not be competitive in tournaments or you may be tagged as a potential sandbagger.

Below are the reasons for unacceptable scores from the USGA Handicap Manual (the comments in parenthesis are mine). There are no others.

1. When fewer than seven holes are played. (You should post 9 hole rounds.)
2. When made on a golf course in an area in which an inactive season established with the authorized golf association is in effect. (Santa Ana does not have one.)
3. When the majority of holes are not played in accordance with the principles of the Rules of Golf (except for preferred lies and conceded putts).
4. When the length of the course is less than 3,000 yards for 18 holes (or less than 1,500 yards for 9 holes). (Santa Ana is over 6000 yards.)
5. When, as a condition of the competition, the maximum number of clubs is less than 14, or types of clubs are limited as, for example, in a competition that allows only iron clubs. (Such as our 4 club tournament.)
6. When scores are made on a course with no USGA Course Rating or Slope Rating. (Santa Ana is a rated course.)
7. When a player carries or uses non-conforming clubs or uses non-conforming balls. (You shouldn't be doing this regardless of where you play.)
8. When artificial devices (as defined under Rule 14-3) are used during the execution of a stroke. (You may use a wheelchair, if necessary.)

### **The Handicap Committee will continue to monitor this issue on a periodic basis by comparing the Santa Ana computerized starter's sheet with rounds posted in GHIN.**

You are always validated on the starter's sheet when you sign-in at the Pro Shop to play and the expectation is that you will finish and post that round. Although we will not check every player to see if all their rounds have been posted, we will do several random audits during the golf season. In addition, we will be randomly checking rounds played with groups like Seniors and Roadrunners.

**If the starter's sheet for a particular date shows that you have played and you did not post a round within a week from the play date the Handicap Committee will post a penalty score to your record in GHIN.**

A penalty score is defined by the USGA as a score equal to the lowest handicap differential from the individual's current scoring record (last 20 scores). The USGA allows the handicap committee to do this without the player's authorization. If this happens, you will see a "P" next to the score. Contact me if there are extenuating circumstances and we will resolve the matter. For example, if the round was not acceptable for posting we will need the reason why. If you still have the signed and attested scorecard from the round in question or you can produce the results sheet from your group we are permitted to post the actual score. If you do not have the card or results sheet then the penalty score will stand.

**Please note that not posting all of your scores may also result in a tournament handicap adjustment by the Handicap Committee.**

Have fun on the course and remember to post all of your ESC scores.

**Play the ball as it lies.**

**Play the course as you find it.**

**When neither can be done, do what is equitable to all concerned.**

To encourage participation in club tournaments, the goal of the Santa Ana Players Club is to provide an equitable, fair, and enjoyable competition for all of our members. The following policies should help achieve this goal.

## SAPC Saturday April 22<sup>ND</sup> Individual Tournament

The Committee recommends that a player play tournaments from the tees they normally play from in daily play which should give them at least 6 scores from those tees that count for their handicap index. In any handicap tournament, a player may play from any teeing ground (blue, white or green); however, if a player does not have at least 6 scores that count from the selected teeing ground, they may still play from the selected tees except that the *Committee* will decide the appropriate handicap stroke deduction from their course handicap. This could be anywhere from a 1-4 stroke reduction depending on the players circumstances and playing history. This reduction will be for the current tournament only and it is not negotiable. A player may always move back from green to white or blue or from white to blue except that for blue tees a 16 handicap or less is required.

**Tournament Flights and Payouts:** Depending on the number of entries in each tournament, the *Committee* will plan to have flights that play from the blue, white and green teeing grounds in each tournament. We encourage eligible SAPC players to enter the blue gross flight to increase the flight size and the winning payouts. If there are at least 3 blue gross participants, there will be a blue gross only flight with payouts based on flight size. If there are 2 or fewer blue gross only participants, then those blue gross players will be moved into the first blue net flight and there will be no gross payout. If you do not want to move from blue gross to blue net, e-mail Mark at [mpvit555@centurylink.net](mailto:mpvit555@centurylink.net) immediately to withdraw from the tournament. You will receive a refund of the tournament entry fee. The *Committee* will attempt to keep the flight sizes from 8-12 players with handicaps within 5 strokes in each flight but that is not a hard requirement. Approximately one third of each flight should place in the prize money. Ties for gross and net prizes will be broken using a scorecard playoff starting on hole 18 and then going backward.

The May 1<sup>st</sup> Course Handicaps will be used to seed the flights. It will be the responsibility of the player with the lower handicap in the flight bracket to contact his opponent and set up a date for the match. The committee will try to keep flight size between 8 and 12 players.

A schedule for completion of matches (no more than 3 weeks) will be posted with the flights after it is determined how many competitors there will be. Phone numbers will be at the Pro Shop desk. **Winner of each match must post the match results.**  
**Failure to complete a match by the deadline will result in forfeiture of one or both players depending on the circumstances.**
