From the Tournament Director

The SAGC season returns on Sat June 6 with an individual tournament.

Attached is the entry form including the details for the new normal for golfing at Santa Ana.

PLEASE read and comply with the new SAGC rules.

In summary:

1. A face mask is required around the pro shop
2. The practice range, putting and chipping areas are CLOSED
3. Arrive 20 minutes before your tee time and leave immediately.
4. The person keeping score is the only one allowed on the porch to post the 4 scores.
5. NO mail entries
6. NO entries at the pro shop
7. A box on the porch is for the entry fee - Do NOT mail your entry. - do NOT try to drop off your entry at the pro shop.

There are 2 ways to enter the June 6 tournament

1. Fill out the form and email to Skip and Mark
2. Email Skip and Mark with:
 - a. your name
 - b. what tees
 - c. Are you going to ride- 1 person per cart
 - d. early/late

All \$25 entry fees will be **collected on Sat before you tee off.**

Do NOT attempt to pay the \$25 fee any other way.

SANTA ANA GOLF COURSE MESSAGE

Thank you for booking your golf reservation at Santa Ana Golf Club. Please review the following protocols as we enter the next phase of golf during the Covid-19 Pandemic.

Priority – Please use proper CDC Public Guidelines on Social Distancing of 6' at all times. If you are feeling ill, please do not show up for your golf reservation for the safety of our employees and fellow golfers. Visit our website (MyNewMexicoGolf.com) for updated player policies during this phase of Covid-19 golf.

General Messaging to Golfers

If you have underlying medical conditions, it is recommended that you not visit our facility. Anyone displaying symptoms of COVID-19 which primarily displays as a persistent cough, will not be permitted on the course. So, if you do not feel well, please stay home, and, when in doubt, get tested.

If you have traveled outside of the state, you are not permitted at our facility until you have self-isolated for a minimum of 14 days. If you live in a household with someone who has COVID-19 or is showing symptoms of COVID-19, please do not come to our facility. If you are showing symptoms of COVID-19, please do not come to our facility. Call your doctor or head to <http://www.nmhealth.org> for more information.

Priority – Please use proper CDC Public Guidelines on Social Distancing of 6' at all times. NO handshaking, NO hugging etc. from arrival until departure. This will be enforced. Failure to observe social distancing risks the closure of the facility, and as such, you will be asked to leave the premises and may be suspended from future play.

THE CLUBHOUSE, LOCKER ROOMS AND RESTAURANT FACILITIES ARE CLOSED.

- The restrooms on the golf course are open and will be disinfected frequently.
- Please bring your own sanitizer and use it each time you touch a foreign surface (door handles, golf cart, etc.).
- We will not be providing scorecards, tees, pencils, water, ice chests or sand bottles on the golf carts at this time.
- Do not handle each other's golf balls, tees, ball markers, etc.
- GPS will be unavailable until further notice.
- Following the recommendations of local and state departments of health, we require all players to wear a mask or some face covering while entering and exiting the facility.

Tee Time Policy/Miscellaneous - Required by the State of NM

Tee times will be available at 12-minute intervals per State of NM Covid-19 Safe Practices to permit for physical distancing and maintenance of pace of play.

Reservation formats allowable:

- Twosomes
- Threesomes under the following scenarios:
 - Three individuals of the same household.
 - Two individuals of the same household + 1 other booked together.
 - Three individuals booked together.
- Foursomes under the following scenarios:
 - Four individuals of the same household.
 - Two individuals of the same household + two individuals of a second same household, booked together, with a maximum of two carts.
 - Two individuals of the same household + two individuals booked together.
- Four individuals walking.
- Limit one rider per cart.

Miscellaneous:

- Limit of 144 players at any time on the course.
- We will maintain a schedule of stringent daily cleaning and sanitizing, specifically carts and other high-touch places.
- Remove or close off access to rakes, ball washers, sand/seed containers and other high-touch objects.
- Flagsticks must remain in hole and plugs must be attached so that balls do not drop to bottom of cup.
- No retail sales in pro shop until further notice.
- Eliminate bag services, club storage and club rentals.
- Utilize signage to communicate occupancy limits and above safety restrictions that affect normal play.
- No alcohol sales until further notice.

- **Best Practices by SAGC, Inc.**
- We are scheduling a greeter to communicate safety restrictions and protocols to our players.
- We are scheduling a marshal(s) to monitor pace of play and adherence to requirements and best practices.
- Installed plexiglass sneeze guards at cash registers for future use.
- If possible, bring your own pull cart. We have limited rentals.
- Max group size is a foursome (no fivesomes).
- Golfers without a pre-scheduled tee time are not permitted. A reservation prior to arriving at the course is required.
- Book reservation by phone only.
- Payments must be made prior to arriving at the golf course and your tee time. Credit cards provided to hold a reservation will be charged the day of your tee time.
- No walk-in business permitted at this time. Must have a premade reservation.

Check-In Policy

- Please do not arrive at the golf course earlier than necessary, 20 minutes is acceptable. Congregating in the parking lot or anywhere at our facility will not be permitted. (Social distancing).
- Change shoes in the parking lot, clubhouse locker rooms are closed.

- Bag services, club storage and club rentals may not be provided to eliminate touch points where the virus might be transmitted.
- You must be prepared to carry your own bag when checking in and place it on a pull cart or golf cart (if utilizing). Please pay for green fee, cart fee and other purchases (if permitted) by debit card, credit card or gift card prior to arrival. Cash transactions not permitted.
- Priority – Please use proper CDC Public Guidelines on Social Distancing of 6’ at all times. Consider continuous putting, 2 ft. “gimmies”, only one player on the tee box at a time; pay attention to the posters that limit the number of people in and around the facility.

Practice Facility Policy

The Practice Facilities are closed until further notice in May. This includes the putting green, chipping greens and driving range.

On-Course Measures

- Ball washers will not be available at this time, so please carry a bottle of water and towel accordingly.
- Bunker rakes will not be available, please smooth sand with your foot or the club, preferred lies are permitted in the bunker or the bunkers are to be played as “Ground Under Repair” at this time.
- Sand/seed containers may not be provided, please repair divots as best you can.
- Cups will be set so balls will not fully enter the hole.
- The flagstick should not be removed from hole and players should refrain from touching the flagstick at all.
- On course drinking water will not be available. Please ensure you have enough refreshments to keep hydrated.
- No garbage cans are available.
- Golf groups will not be permitted to play through.

Post-Round Policy

- Please return your golf cart to the designated cart drop off area.
- Garbage and recycling bins will be available in the designated cart drop off area, however, please consider taking it home with you to minimize potential exposure.
- Please COMPLETELY empty your cart of all personal belongings and garbage.
- Following play exit the course as promptly as possible and avoid excess socializing in the parking lot after your round.

Golfer Adherence

All policies will be enforced and anyone not in compliance with these policies will be asked to leave the premises and may be suspended from future play.

SAPC Saturday June 6th, 2020 Individual Tournament

The Committee recommends that a player play tournaments from the tees they normally play from in daily play. The blue tees require a 16 or less handicap.

Tournament Flights and Payouts: Depending on the number of entries in each tournament, the *Committee* will plan to have flights that play from the blue, blue gross, blue hybrid gross, white gross, white and green teeing grounds in each tournament. We encourage eligible SAPC players to enter the blue gross/blue hybrid gross/white gross flight to increase the flight size and the winning payouts. If there are 2 or fewer blue gross/blue hybrid gross/white gross only participants, then those players will be moved into the first net flight and there will be no gross payout. The *Committee* will attempt to keep the flight sizes from 8-12 players with handicaps within 5 strokes in each flight but that is not a hard requirement. Approximately one third of each flight should place in the prize money. Prize monies will be split for ties.

Entry Fee: \$25.00 per person

Entry fee is due on the morning of the tournament – there will be a box on the porch in which to put your fee.

Entry Deadline: All entries must be received by Wednesday June 3rd by 5pm

Tee Times will be emailed to all players as soon as they have been established. The tee times will be posted on the web at mynewmexicogolf.com or call the pro shop.

SAPC RULES
IF YOU FEEL SICK OR HAVE BEEN EXPOSED TO THE COVID-19 VIRUS - STAY HOME
IF YOU HAVE TRAVELED OUTSIDE OF THE STATE YOU MUST SELF-ISOLATED FOR 14 DAYS – STAY HOME
IF YOU LIVE IN A HOUSEHOLD WITH SOMEONE WHO HAS COVID-19 OR IS SHOWING SYMPTOMS – STAY HOME
Arrive 20 min before your tee time
No lingering on the patio or in the parking lot
MANDATORY face mask from the time you get out of your car until you get to the first tee AND therefore from the 18 th green until you get back into your car.
1 person in each 4-some keeps the scores
1 person enters the GROSS score on the flight list on the patio and then disposes the scorecard – do NOT put the score card in the entry fee box.
Leave immediately upon finishing your round.
Results will be emailed as soon as possible
All players are responsible for ESCing their scores and posting to GHIN
Ties – monies will be split
NO entries in the SAPC box at the pro shop. All entries must be by email.
NO US Mail entries
There will be a box on the patio for the entry fee on the day of the tournament
Continuous putting – the soft spikes won't mess with your line!!!
If your ball hits the hole and bounces out – that's the rub of the green – play the ball as it lies.
All players are encouraged to walk – We have a limited number of carts available and when they are all reserved no more riders will be allowed in the tournament.

**June 20th & 21st, 2020 Saturday & Sunday SAGC
President Cup**

Play will be net at full handicap for Blue, White, & Green Flights. Blue Gross/Blue Hybrid Gross/White Gross only players will play scratch within their flight, but receive full handicap toward the overall President's Cup. Blue Flights must have a course handicap of 16 or less. The President's Cup will be inscribed with the name of the player from any Flight who has the lowest over-all net score. The Cup winner will receive a bonus Pro Shop Certificate as well as any Flight winnings.

Tournament Flights and Payouts: We encourage eligible SAGC players to enter the gross flights to increase the flight size and the winning payouts. If there are at least 3 gross participants, there will be a gross only flight with payouts based on flight size. If there are 2 or fewer gross only participants, then those gross players will be moved into the first net flight and there will be no gross payout. The *Committee* will attempt to keep the flight sizes from 8-12 players with handicaps within 5 strokes in each flight but that is not a hard requirement. Approximately one third of each flight should place in the prize money. Ties will split the prize monies

Entry Fee: \$50.00 per person

Entry fee is due on Saturday morning of the tournament – there will be a box on the porch in which to put your fee.

Entry Deadline: All entries must be received by June 17th Wednesday by 5pm

Tee Times will be emailed to all players. The tee times will also be posted on the web at mynewmexicogolf.com or call the pro shop.
