

Santa Ana Golf Club FootGolf Rules and Ettiquette

Dress: FootGolfers shall wear traditional golf attire and shorts are recommended (cap & argyle socks encouraged).

Indoor soccer & athletic shoes are permitted (NO CLEATS).

Please see map for course layout.

Pace of Play = 2 hours. Maintain pace with the group in front of you.

RESPECT all golfers on the course. No outside food & beverage.

1. FootGolf tee markers are Pumpkin and Turquoise. FootGolf greens can be identified by orange soccer flags and are in numerical order.
2. FootGolf play is not permitted on the golf greens. If ball comes to rest on a green retrieve and place it 2 steps off the green where it crossed. Add a 1 stroke penalty.
3. A kick is played in a single movement and your foot must be separate from the ball before each kick. Pushing the ball with the top/bottom of your foot is not allowed.
4. The ball must completely come to rest before the next kick is made. It is against the rules to stop or kick a moving ball even if being influenced by the wind.
5. Play the ball as it lies and you may not move the ball or fixed objects & growing plants/shrubs. Mark (with a coin) & lift your ball if obstructing another player.
6. Order of play is established based on the lowest score on the previous hole. The player with the best score will kick off first followed by the 2nd lowest and so on.
7. The player farthest from the hole is always first to play.
8. If the ball lands in a water hazard, retrieve or replace it within 2 steps from the closest land point from where the ball entered the water hazard (marked with red/yellow lines) and adding a one stroke penalty. You can also place the ball at the position of the previous kick, play again and add a one stroke penalty.
9. Out of bounds is indicated by white stakes and fences. Play the same as if the ball entered a water hazard.
